



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
SERAMPORE COLLEGE (UNIVERSITY)  
SERAMPORE, DISTRICT HOOGHLY, WEST BENGAL, INDIA  
AND  
WILLIAM CAREY UNIVERSITY  
HATTIESBURG, MISSISSIPPI, UNITED STATES**

Serampore College, Serampore, District Hooghly, West Bengal, India, represented by its Principal, Dr. Vansanglura and William Carey University at 710 William Carey Parkway, Hattiesburg, Mississippi, United States, represented by its President, Dr. Tommy King, have agreed to the following terms:

1. That this agreement is intended to strengthen the historic relationship between Serampore College and William Carey University.
2. To recognize and celebrate the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Serampore College and the 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of William Carey University.
3. To promote academic and cooperative initiatives between both institutions in the areas of instruction, research, and mission work.
4. A variety of collaborative approaches may be employed, such as:
  - a. Invitations to faculty members to serve as guest instructors;
  - b. Admitting students for short-term study and longer-term study;
  - c. Collaborative research on the life and times of William Carey;
  - d. Collaborative mission work for short-term trips and longer-term intercultural studies and Christian ministry internships;
  - e. Collaborative efforts in support of Bible translation;
  - f. Exchange of scholarly and pedagogical materials;
  - g. Participation in academic conferences / seminars;
  - h. Other cooperative efforts as agreed upon by both institutions.


5. That the parties recognize that implementing any agreement will depend upon the academic interest and expertise of individual faculty members and upon the availability of financial resources.
6. This agreement is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the agreement upon giving one year's notice. It is assumed that such action would be taken only after mutual consultation in order to minimize potential inconvenience to the other party.
7. That such agreement is not intended to be a legally binding document. Rather, it is meant to describe the nature and cooperative intentions of those institutions involved, and to suggest guidelines for cooperation. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor may any constraints be imposed by either upon the other.
