NOTICE

In compliance to the notification of the Government of West Bengal, Department of Higher Education Memo no. 89-Edn(CS)/10M-32/2021 dated 31.01.2022, it is hereby notified that students will be allowed to return to the campus and accommodate in the College Hostels accordingly:

1. The students of BD III & IV will be allowed to come to the campus for offline classes. BD I & II will continue with the online mode of classes till further notice.
2. All M.Th and D.Th students are allowed to come to the campus.
3. BD III & IV students should arrive on the campus between 4th -12th February, 2022.
4. All Vaccinated/Unvaccinated students should produce RT-PCR Negative report taken within 72 hours and their full vaccination certificate (those who are Vaccinated) to the Wardens on their arrival to the campus.
5. Any student failing to fulfil the requirement will stay in the quarantine centre arranged by the authority and go for the RT-PCR test.
6. All students coming to the campus should inform the date of their journey and arrival to the vice-principal and the hostel wardens, so that they would be granted leave of absence.
7. All students BD, M.Th & D.Th coming to the hostel will have to undergo quarantine in their own room for 7 days.
8. Online classes will continue till the students are in quarantine, after which Offline classes will resume for BD III & IV from 21st February, 2022.

Note:

1. Students accommodated in the Hostels should strictly follow the Covid safety norms.
2. Married students will not be allowed to bring their families till the end of the academic session i.e., May, 2021-22. They would be given single accommodation.
3. No students will be allowed in the campus without masks and sanitizers. Students are strictly prohibited from sharing food and beverages and all other Covid inappropriate behaviour.
